The APPG on Drones is pleased to host a private view of 'Eye in the Sky' in partnership with Human Rights Charity Reprieve and the Entertainment One UK. 'Eye in the Sky' is a new British thriller about a top secret drone operation to capture terrorists in Kenya starring Helen Mirren as Colonel Katherine Powell, a UK-based military officer in command of the operation. Based on remote surveillance and on-the-ground intelligence, Powell discovers the targets are planning a suicide bombing and the mission escalates from "capture" to "kill." But as American pilot Steve Watts (Aaron Paul) is about to engage, a nine-year old girl enters the kill zone triggering an international dispute, reaching the highest levels of US and British government, over the moral, political and personal implications of remote warfare. 'Eye in the Sky' is released in cinemas nationwide on April 15th 2016.

The film (102 mins) will be followed by a 30 minute panel discussion with Guy Hibbert, writer of the screenplay and Clive Stafford Smith, Director of Reprieve. Guy and Clive will be joined by Cian Westmoreland, formerly from the 606 Air Control Squadron in Germany and the 73rd Expeditionary Air Control Squadron, Kandahar, who served to support the communications infrastructure of the US drone program.
